

## Leadership Training Module 1- How To Lead A Victory Life Group (VLG)

### Preparations

- Find one partner to work with you on the group
- Specify a day and time of the week that you can get people together
- Make clear the text for the Victory Life Group is the Bible
- Get everyone access to Victory Bible Plan Online, Print, or on VWC email list
- Start inviting people to your weekly meeting.
- Try to get everyone with the same version of the Bible. Victory uses Shinkaiyaku (JP) and New King James Version (NKJV) in English.

### During The Meeting

1. People share in sentences not paragraphs
2. Focus only on what the passage is saying (no outside passages)
3. Give people time to respond (don't be afraid of silence). People can 'pass' if they don't have something to share
4. Moderate, don't teach. Let God's Word speak for itself.
5. Ask questions using God's Word not some opinion.
6. Keep life group on schedule (generally 45 minute session).

### 1. Get Started

Pray out loud-thanking God for leading the group and Holy Spirit for being your teacher

### 2. Opening

What are you thankful for this week?

What problems have you experienced this past week? (Remember sentences not paragraphs)

How can this group help you? Or how is this group helping you?

Who did you share last week's VLG insights with?

How did you follow what you learned last week?

### 3. Read

A Chapter- Pick 1 of the Chapters from your Victory Bible Reading for that day or week and divide number of verses by the people in your group (40 verses with 4 people= each read 10 verses).

Read the verses together. Larger groups, you can select one reader for complete passage.

### 4. Discover

What happens in this passage?

What did you like or find significant about the passage?

What did you not like about this passage? Why?

What does this passage tell us about God?

What does this passage tell us about people?

What other questions do you have about this passage?

### Other questions-

How does this passage change how you view God?

How does this passage change how you treat others?

How does this passage change how you live your life?

What specifically, will you do this coming week to obey this passage?

### 5. Close

Have someone in the group (volunteer) close in prayer, thanking God for making His truth known, and asking for God's help/provision regarding specific member needs (that were shared above).
